## ADMISSION CRITERIA

### Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in B.Com.(Accountancy) for the Session 2017-18

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. or equivalent Examination for admission to B.Com. Honours in Accountancy having the following eligibility criteria.

**Admission will be made on the basis of merit only.**

#### Eligibility Criteria:

- Candidates having **50%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) and **45%** in **Accountancy**.
- OR**
- **55%** in **Accountancy**.
- **50%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) in case of those candidates who did not have **Accountancy** in their previous qualifying examination but had related subjects as prescribed by the University, provided they satisfy all other University clauses & norms.
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC/PH** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidate will be eligible for admission to Honours in Accountancy.
- For SC/ST candidate 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.

# **Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in Bengali for the Session 2017-18**

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. or equivalent Examination for admission to B.A. Honours in **Bengali** having the following eligibility criteria.

**Admission will be made on the basis of merit**

**only. Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates having **55%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) and **55%** marks in **Bengali**.
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC/PH** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidates will be eligible for admission to Honours in **Bengali**.
- **Bengali** Honours students will be allowed to take either **Education, History, or Education, Philosophy**, (subject to availability) only as elective subjects.
- For SC/ST candidate 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.

## **Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in Botany** **for the Session 2017-18**

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. (Science) or equivalent Examination for admission to B.Sc. Honours in **Botany** having the following eligibility criteria.

**Admission will be made on the basis of merit only. Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates having **50%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVIS) and **45%** in **Biology/Botany**.

**OR**

- **55% in Biology/Botany**  
Candidates must have passed Chemistry” as main subject in H.S. or equivalent examination.
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC/PH** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidate will be eligible for admission to Honours in **Botany**.
- **For SC/ST candidate** 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.

## **Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in Education for the Session 2017 -18**

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. or equivalent Examination for admission to B.A. Honours in **Education** having the following eligibility criteria.  
**Admission will be made on the basis of merit only.**

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates having **50%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVIS) and **45%** in **Education /Psychology /Philosophy/ Mathematics/ Sociology/ Economics/ Political Science/ History**
- OR**
- **55% in the subject.**
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC/PH** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidate will be eligible for admission to Honours in **Education**.
- **Education** Honours students will be allowed to take **History & Pol. Sc.** only as elective subjects.
- **For SC/ST candidate** 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.

## **Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in Economics for the Session 2017-18**

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. or equivalent Examination for admission to B.Sc. Honours in **Economics** having the following eligibility criteria.

**Admission will be made on the basis of merit**

**only. Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates having **55%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) and **55% in Economics/Mathematics.**

**OR**

- **60% in aggregate** on the basis of marks in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) & **50% in Economics/Mathematics.**
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC/PH** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- Candidates must passed in Mathematics at the H.S. Examination (10+2) conducted by the West Bengal Council of H.S. Education or its equivalent examination in Mathematics/ Business Mathematics. Students who have passed Business Economics including Business Mathematics in H.S.(10+2) level from West Bengal Council of H.S. Education are also eligible for admission in the Honours Course in Economics.
- **Economics** Honours students will be allowed to take **Mathematics & Pol. Sc.** only as elective subjects.
- **For SC/ST candidate** 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.

## **Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in English** **for the Session 2017-18**

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. or equivalent Examination for admission to B.A. Honours in **English** having the following eligibility criteria.

**Admission will be made on the basis of merit**

**only. Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates having **55%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) and **60% in English.**

**OR**

- **60% in aggregate** on the basis of marks in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) & **55% in English.**
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC/PH** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidate will be eligible for admission to Honours in **English.**
- **English** Honours students will be allowed to take **History & Pol. Sc.** only as elective subjects.
- **For SC/ST candidate** 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.

# **Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in Food & Nutrition for the Session 2017-18**

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. or equivalent Examination for admission to B.Sc. Honours in **Food & Nutrition** having the following eligibility criteria.

**Admission will be made on the basis of merit only.**

## **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates passed with Chemistry and having **50%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) and **55%** in Food & Nutrition.

**OR**

- **50%** marks in **aggregate** on the basis of marks in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) & **50%** marks each in Biology & Chemistry.

**OR**

- Candidates **must have passed Chemistry** as main subject in H.S. or equivalent examination.
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidate will be eligible for admission to Honours in **Food & Nutrition**.
- **Food & Nutrition** Honours students will be allowed to take **Chemistry & Zoology** only as elective subjects.
- **For SC/ST candidate** 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.

## Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in Geography(B.A./B.Sc.) for the Session 2017-18

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. or equivalent Examination for admission to B.A. Honours in **Geography** having the following eligibility criteria. **Admission will be made on the basis of merit only.**

### Eligibility Criteria:

- Candidates having **60%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) and **65%** marks in **Geography**.
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC/PH** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidate will be eligible for admission to Honours in Geography.
- **Geography** Honours (B.A.) students will be allowed to take **Pol. Sc. & History** only as elective subjects.
- **Geography** Honours (B.Sc.) students will be allowed to take **Economics & History** only as elective subjects.
- For SC/ST candidate 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.



## **Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in History** **for the Session 2017-18**

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. or equivalent Examination for admission to B.A. Honours in **History** having the following eligibility criteria.

**Admission will be made on the basis of merit**

**only. Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates having **50%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVIS) and **45%** marks in **History**.

**OR**

- **55%** marks in **History**.
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC/PH** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidate will be eligible for admission to Honours in History.
- **History** Honours students will be allowed to take **Pol. Sc. & Education** only as elective subjects.
- **For SC/ST candidate** 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.

## **Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in Philosophy for the Session 2017-18**

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. or equivalent Examination for admission to B.A. Honours in **Philosophy** having the following eligibility criteria.  
**Admission will be made on the basis of merit only.**

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates having **50%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVIS) and **45%** marks in **Philosophy**.
- OR
- **55%** marks in **Philosophy**.
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC/PH** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidate will be eligible for admission to Honours in **Philosophy**.
- **Philosophy** Honours students will be allowed to take **History & Pol. Sc.** only as elective subjects.
- **For SC/ST candidate** 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.

## **Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in Political Science for the Session 2017-18**

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. or equivalent Examination for admission to B.A. Honours in **Political Science** having the following eligibility criteria.

**Admission will be made on the basis of merit**

**only. Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates having **50%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) and **45%** marks in **Political Science**.

**OR** ➤

**55%** marks in **Political Science**.

- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC/PH** candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidate will be eligible for admission to Honours in **Political Science**.
- **Political Science** Honours students will be allowed to take **History & Education** only as elective subjects.
- For SC/ST candidate 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.

## **Admission Notice for Part-I Hons. in Zoology** **for the Session 2017-18**

Admission forms will be issued to regular successful candidates who have passed H.S. (Science) or equivalent Examination for admission to B.Sc. Honours in **Zoology** having the following eligibility criteria.

**Admission will be made on the basis of merit**

**only. Eligibility Criteria:**

- Candidates having **60%** marks in aggregate on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in order of marks (excluding compulsory ENVS) and **60% marks in Biology/Zoology.**
- Candidates **must have passed Chemistry** as main subject in H.S. or equivalent examination.
- Admission to seats reserved for **SC/ST/OBC PH**/candidates will be made on the basis of merit as per Govt. and CU Rules.
- No **compartmental** candidate will be eligible for admission to Honours in **Zoology.**
- **For SC/ST candidate** 40% marks in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject.
